Program/Project: The Institute for Rare Diseases is a single institution resulting from the territorially and functionally union between the Information Centre for Rare Diseases and Orphan Drugs (ICRDOD, est. 2004), the “RareDis” Medical Centre (est. 2009) and the Centre for Health Technology Assessment and Analysis (CAHTA, est. 2013). ICRDOD, “RareDis” Medical Centre and CAHTA have been launched by the Bulgarian Association for Promotion of Education and Science as project activities, explicitly designed to provide information, consulting and research expertise in the fields of public health, health technology assessment and rare diseases. The Institute for Rare Diseases is the first and only interdisciplinary and multifunctioning rare disease organization of this kind in Eastern Europe.
